Formulated by the Human Services Commission Regarding the Community

Investment Program Funding for FY13-14

#### **SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

Staff recommends a motion accepting the recommendations made by the Human Services Commission to allocate the \$150,000 Community Investment Program Funds for FY13-14.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On April 3, 2013, the City Council hosted a Work Session regarding Current and Future Challenges facing Social Services in San Leandro. The discussion included input from several social service agencies located within and/or serving San Leandro.

On May 6, 2013, the City Council authorized the City Manager to implement a Community Investment Program of \$300,000 in which \$150,000 should be used to support community services (\$15,000 was specifically allocated to Eden I & R). The City Council directed that the Human Services Commission come forward with recommendations for allocating the remaining funds.

On June 26, 2013 the Human Services Commission formulated funding recommendations based on applications received in January 2013 for the Community Assistance Program (CAP), plus an additional request from Davis Street Family Resource Center to support core operations. The original CAP applications and applicant presentations were utilized in creating the funding recommendations set forth.

On May 24th all eligible agencies were notified of the newly designated funds. Applicants were invited to be present at the regularly scheduled Human Services Commission meeting in June as the recommendations were being formulated.
