

Project Benefits

- \$178MM investment in the community
- 9.5 miles of newly paved streets
- Improved Safety and Security Features Pedestrian and Transit
- Enhanced ADA features
- Career employment opportunities now, during construction and after service begins
- Improved access to jobs and services along E. 14th







Progress Since July 2012 San Leandro City Council Adoption

- Complied with San Leandro's Conditions of Approval
- Relocated three stations, added signal at Haas St. and refined location of pedestrian signals based on community and city staff input
- Enhanced signage and accessibility features in station design
- Collaborated with BART and City staff to develop transit center improvement project at San Leandro BART station







Progress Since July 2012 San Leandro City Council Adoption

- "Right-sized" station canopy size to match ridership forecasts
- Developed strategy for Public Art Enhancement program
- Hosted 2 public outreach meetings and 2 contractor outreach meetings attended by 5 San Leandro-based businesses
- Defined implementation plan (3 construction packages)
- Refined project scope and cost from concept to 35% preliminary engineering design







What's Next?

- Continue design process with City and community for Utility Relocations and Major Construction
- Define level of service on E 14th beyond San Leandro BART
- Conduct intensive outreach effort during next six months focusing on project benefits, careers policy and contract opportunities
- Submit Small Starts Grant Agreement application to secure remaining \$27.6 million in federal funding
- Finalize utility agreements
- Finalize Artistic Enhancement RFQ and initiate procurement
- Host contractor and careers outreach workshop in August


















14th STREET AND GEORGIA WAY - NORTHBOUND - LOOKING NORTHWEST EXISTING






