 Furthers City's Annual Action Plan for U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to create permanent supporting housing for persons with special needs

Who is Hello Housing?



- An established 501(c)(3) non-profit based in San Francisco
- Established in 2005
- Developed 110 homes in the Bay Area
 - 65 homes serving adults developmental disabilities or mental illness
 - 45 single-family homes through the NSP1 and NSP2 programs

324 Lille Avenue Property



- Built in 1941
- 2-bedroom / 1-bath single-family home
- 1,030 sq ft.
- Total Project Cost \$461,000:
 - Acquisition Cost: \$213,300
 - ➤ By Hello Housing as a vacant and foreclosed property using federal Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP1) stimulus funds
 - Estimated Rehabilitation Cost: \$247,700

Proposal



- Requesting \$100k in federal HOME funds from the City
 - Loan and Affordability terms: 55 years; 3% interest; residual receipts
 - Other leveraged funds include: \$361k Livermore NSP1 Consortium
- Serves very low income developmentally disabled renters at affordable rents
- Rehab work includes modifying the home for the accessibility needs of renter (e.g. roll-in shower, widened doorways, wheelchair ramp at entry way, lowered kitchen countertop)
- Ownership and management will be transferred to nonprofit Housing Consortium of the East Bay (HCEB)

Tonight's Action

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- Staff recommends Council reviews and approves:
 - \$100k federal HOME Program loan to Hello Housing and related legal documents, including Loan Agreement, Regulatory Agreement, Deed of Trust, and Promissory Note
