Mia Ousley commented on the request for a public nuisance ordinance that she made in 2013 on behalf of the Broadmoor Neighborhood Association. Ms. Ousley requested an update from the City in time for the BNA's general membership meeting in March.

Damian Starling, member of ILWU Local 6, expressed appreciation to the City Council for adopting the Living Wage Ordinance, and commented on the need for affordable health care, sick leave and paid vacation for recycling workers at ACI.

Delfina Casillas, member of ILWU Local 6, commented through interpreter Augustin Ramirez that the job of a recycling worker for ACI is hard, dirty and dangerous work. Ms. Casillas thanked the City Council and ACI for implementing the Living Wage Ordinance, commenting that local businesses will also benefit from the dollars spent by the workers.

Agustin Ramirez, representing ILWU Local 6, thanked the City Council and ACI for implementing the Living Wage Ordinance. Mr. Ramirez commented that the wages of recycling workers in San Leandro, Alameda and Livermore are still below that of workers from other nearby cities.
