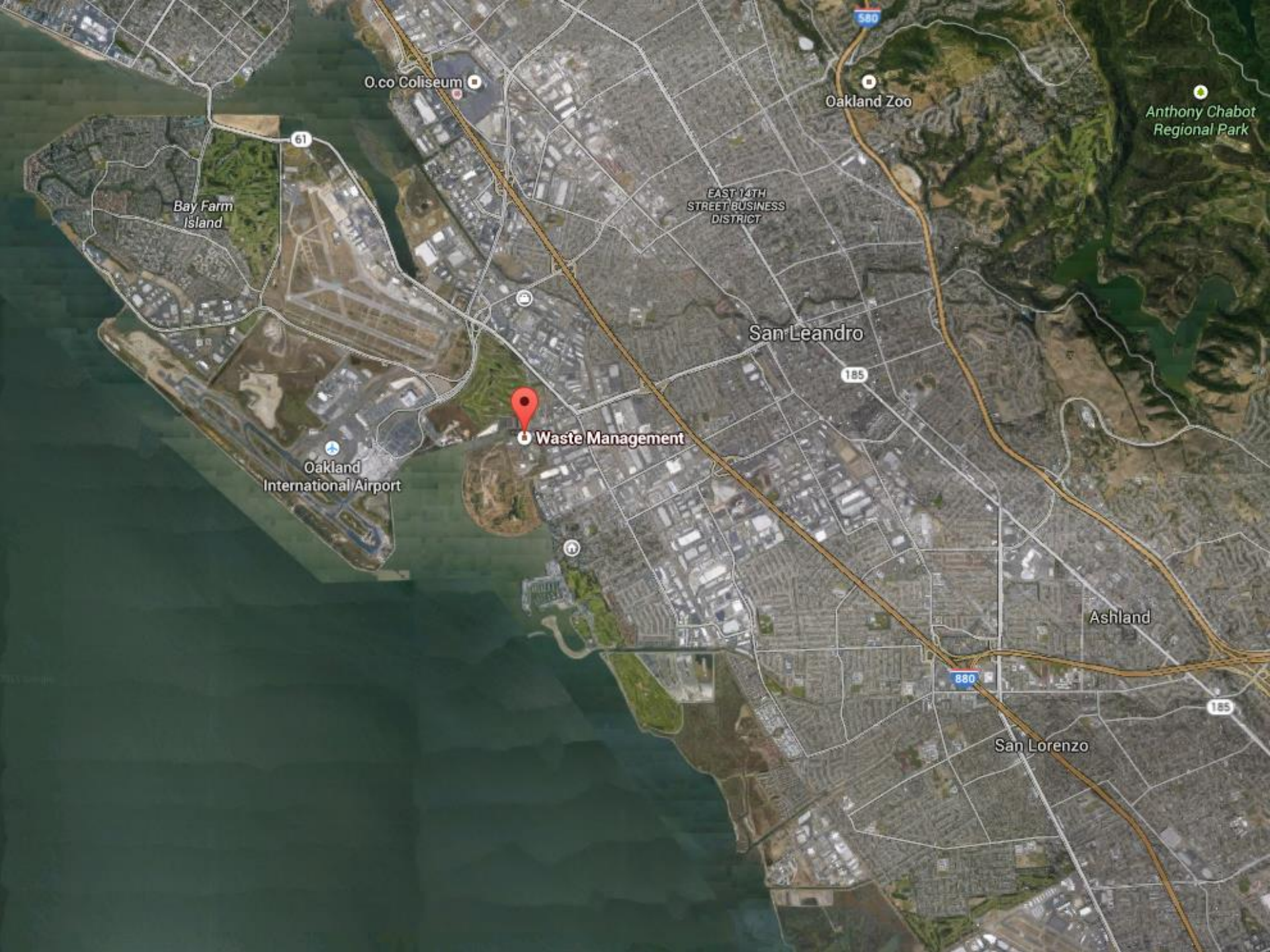

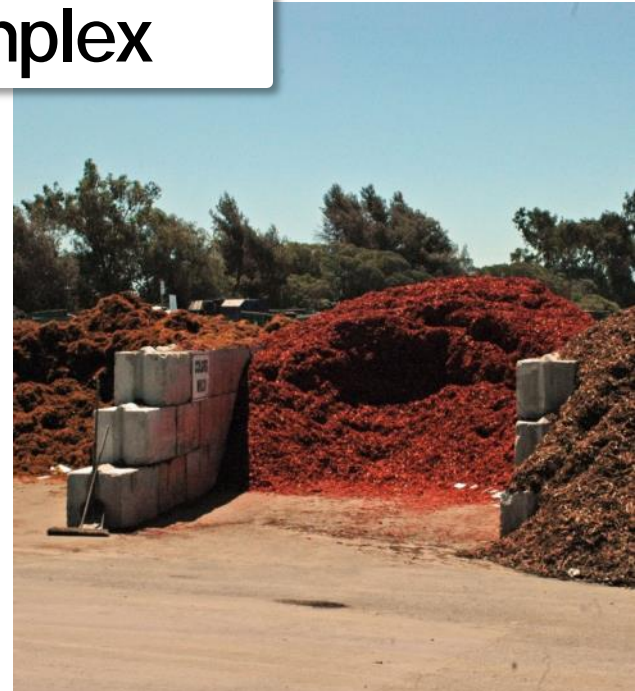

History of Davis Street

- Landfill from '40s-'70s
- Closed and capped in 1979
- Transfer Station established 1979
- Processing in 2002
- Continued evolution since





Davis Street's partnership with the City of San Leandro

- Generated over \$8 million to the City since 2010
- Top 10 largest employers in San Leandro
- Chamber of Commerce member for 60+ years
- Leadership San Leandro sponsor
- Annual America Recycles Day Event



Davis Street Today

- 3 transfer stations and 3 processing facilities on 52 acres
- Receives ~4,000 tons/day of materials
- 320 employees
- iRECYCLE@School Education Center; ~10,000 kids tour the site annually in partnership with StopWaste
- WM EarthCare Landscape Center



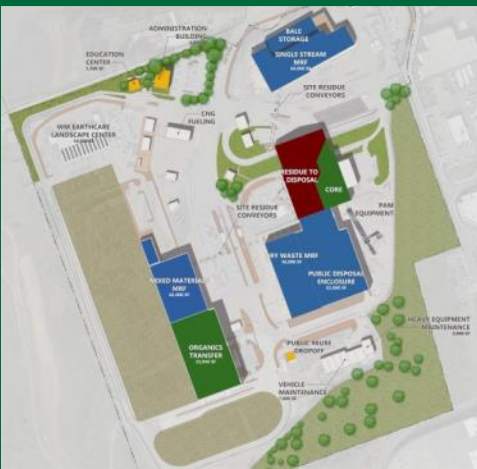
Davis Street Influences

 - Develop a method for measuring diversion from C&D and refuse

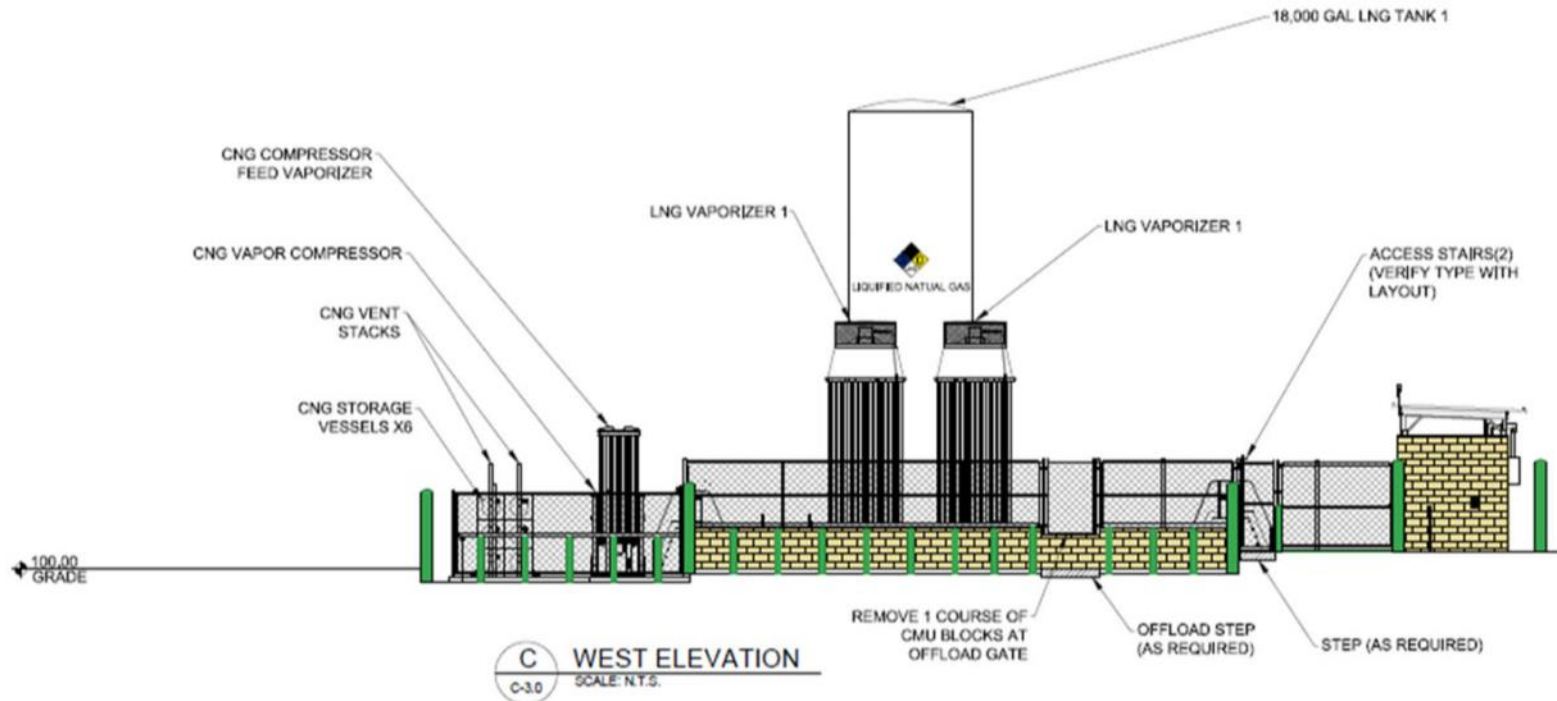


Davis Street's Future
