TITLE: Staff Report for a City of San Leandro City Council Resolution Declaring the

Results of the General Municipal Election Held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

The City of San Leandro held its General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. The City's election was consolidated with the Statewide General Election and was conducted by the Alameda County Registrar of Voters (ROV).

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution declaring the results of the City of San Leandro's General Municipal Election for City Council Districts 2, 4, and 6, and Measure VV.

BACKGROUND

On July 6, 2020, the San Leandro City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-073, calling its General Municipal Election, to be held on November 3, 2020, and requesting that the Board of Supervisors permit the consolidation of the City's election with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date. On July 20, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-103, submitting one question to the voters at the November 3, 2020 election. The election resolution included a request that the Alameda County Board of Supervisors permit the consolidation of the City's General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election, and that the ROV provide necessary services related to the conduct of the election.

San Leandro's City Charter requires election of candidates by a 50% plus one majority. Since 2010, San Leandro has used the Ranked Choice Voting (RCV) system. However, for the November 3, 2020 election, the candidate for District 6 ran unopposed and there were only two candidates for Districts 2 and 4 respectively, which eliminated the need for RCV.

As required by the California Elections Code, an official canvass was performed by the ROV, and a Statement of Election Results was submitted to the City. A resolution accepting the Statement

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of Election Results and declaring the results of the election is provided for the City Council's adoption.

The following outlines the results of the November 3, 2020 election:

District 2 - Bryan Azevedo, Councilmember, for a full term of four years from and after January 1, 2021, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

District 4 - Fred Simon, Councilmember, for a full term of four years from and after January 1, 2021, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

District 6 - Pete Ballew, Councilmember, for a full term of four years from and after January 1, 2021, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

Measure VV - a majority of the affirmative votes were cast to increase the existing real property transfer tax rate.

Current Agency Policies

Section 225(b) of the Charter of the City of San Leandro requires a successful candidate for elective office to receive at least 50% plus one of the votes cast for that office. In the event that no candidate receives 50% plus one of the votes cast for that office, the Charter requires the City Council to provide for a runoff vote to determine the person elected. The Charter provides that the runoff system may include an instant runoff voting system (i.e., RCV).

Previous Actions

On April 19, 2010, the City Council passed to print and adopted Ordinance No. 2010-005, providing for the conduct of the General Municipal Election using RCV. The ordinance remains in effect for this election.

On July 6, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-073, calling the November 3, 2020 General Municipal Election, requesting the Alameda County Board of Supervisors permit the consolidation of the City's General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election, and requesting that the ROV conduct the election on the City's behalf.

On July 20, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-103, placing Measure VV on the ballot.

Summary of Public Outreach Efforts

A Candidate Information page was added to the City website, listing the candidates' contact information, ballot designations, ballot statements, and pre-election campaign financial statements. The page was updated as new information was received.

On September 11, 2020, a Notice of Nominees for Public Office and Measure to be Voted On was published in the Daily Review newspaper, pursuant to Elections Code Section 12110.

On September 30, 2020, City staff conducted a Candidate Orientation for all City Council candidates, and members of the public were invited. The Orientation provided information on

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City services and projects.

A webpage for The Notice of Nominees for Public Office and Measures to be Voted On was added to the City's website. A link to translate the website was prominently placed in the upper corner of the page to allow easy translation of the Notice into the four required languages: Spanish, Chinese, Tagalog and Vietnamese.

An Election Campaign Sign webpage was created, to provide candidates and members of the public with information on the rules governing temporary political campaign signs.

Fiscal Impacts

The 2020 election is estimated to cost \$450,800. There is sufficient funding in the budget to cover the election's costs.

Budget Authority

There is \$475,000 in the FY 2020-2021 General Fund budget (Account 010-11-031-5890) for funding the election costs.

the General Municipal Election Held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 (accepts the statement of election results for City Council Districts 2, 4, and 6 and Measure

VV)

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of San Leandro on Tuesday, the 3rd of November, 2020, in consolidation with the Statewide General Election, as required by the California Elections Code, the Charter of the City of San Leandro, and the City of San Leandro Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given as required by law, voting precincts were properly established, election officers were duly and regularly appointed, election supplies furnished, and in all respects said election was held and conducted, the votes cast were received and canvassed, and the returns thereof made, determined and declared in the time, form and manner required by law regulating and controlling such elections; and

WHEREAS, the qualified electors cast ballots at said election for the following Officials:

City Council Member, District 2 City Council Member, District 4 City Council Member, District 6

WHEREAS, the qualified electors cast ballots at said election upon the following proposed Measure:

Measure VV - To maintain City of San Leandro services, with revenue that cannot be taken by the State, including: repairing potholes/streets; supporting seniors, families and local small businesses through COVID-19 economic recovery; preserving 911 emergency response; maintaining youth violence prevention programs; and general city services; shall San

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Leandro increase the existing real property transfer tax rate, collected when property is sold, by \$5 per \$1,000 in valuation, generating an additional \$4,000,000 annually, until repealed by voters, all funds benefiting San Leandro?

WHEREAS, a canvass of the returns of said election was made by the Registrar of Voters of Alameda County, a copy of which is attached; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Leandro met in the special meeting place of the Council on the 14th day of December 2020, to declare the results of said election in compliance with Section 10263 of the California Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds as a result of said canvass that the number of votes cast, the names of the persons voted for, and other matters required by law are as hereinafter stated.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Leandro does **RESOLVE** and declare as follows:

- A General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of San Leandro on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 at the time and in the form and manner required by law.
- There were 5 Accessible Voting Locations established for the purpose of holding said election.
- The total number of votes cast at said election, for the candidates for City Council Districts 2, 4, and 6 was 39,821.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that at said election, the following persons were elected to the following offices respectively:

Bryan Azevedo, Councilmember, District 2, for a full term of four years from and after January 1, 2021, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

Fred Simon, Councilmember, District 4, for a full term of four years from and after January 1, 2021, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

Pete Ballew, Councilmember, District 6, for a full term of four years from and after January 1, 2021, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Measure VV received a majority of the affirmative votes cast at said election for said Measure and is hereby declared to have passed. The approval of Measure VV results in the adoption of an Ordinance of the People of the City of San Leandro, to increase the existing real property transfer tax rate.

TITLE: ORDINANCE of the City of San Leandro City Council Amending Section 2-3-105

of the San Leandro Municipal Code Relating to the Real Property Transfer Tax.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SAN LEANDRO DO ORDAIN as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> **AMENDMENT TO THE SAN LEANDRO MUNICIPAL CODE.** San Leandro Municipal Code Section 2-3-105 of the San Leandro Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows (with additions in *italics* and deletions in <u>strikethrough</u>):

"CHAPTER 2-3 REAL PROPERTY TRANSFER TAX

2-3-105 IMPOSITION OF TAX

(a) A tax is hereby imposed on each transfer by deed, instrument or writing, by which any lands, tenements or other real property located in the City, are sold or granted, assigned, transferred or otherwise conveyed to, or vested in, a purchaser or purchasers thereof, or any other person or persons at or by the direction of said purchaser or purchasers, when the value of the consideration exceeds One Hundred Dollars, said tax is to be at the rate of Six Dollars (\$6.00) Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) for each One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or fractional part of One Thousand Dollars or the value of the consideration.

As used herein, "value of the consideration" means the total consideration, paid or delivered or contracted to be paid or delivered in return for the transfer or any lands, tenements or other real property, including the amount of any indebtedness, existing immediately prior to the transfer which is secured by a lien, deed of trust or other encumbrance on the property conveyed and which continues to be secured by such lien, deed or trust or encumbrance after said transfer, and also including the amount of any indebtedness which is secured by a lien, deed of trust or encumbrance given or placed upon the property in connection with the transfer to secure the payment of the purchase price or any part thereof which remains unpaid at the time of the transfer. "Value er of the consideration" also includes the amount of any special assessment levied or imposed upon the lands, tenements or other real property by a public body, district or agency,

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where said special assessment is a lien or encumbrance on the property and the purchaser or transferee agrees to pay such special assessment or takes the property subject to the lien of such special assessment. The value of any lien or encumbrance of a type other than those which are hereinabove specifically included, existing immediately prior to the transfer and remaining after said transfer, shall not be included in determining the value of the consideration. If the value of the consideration cannot be definitely determined, or is left open to be fixed by future contingencies, "value of the consideration" shall be deemed to mean the fair market value of the property at the time of transfer after deducting the amount of any lien or encumbrance if any of a type which would be excluded in determining the value of the consideration pursuant to the above provisions of this section.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> **FUTURE AMENDMENTS.** To the extent allowed under Article XIII C of the California Constitution, this Ordinance may be amended by the City Council without a vote of the people, except that voter approval shall be required for any amendment that increases the tax, within the meaning of Government Code section 53750(h), beyond the levels authorized by this chapter.

SECTION 3. CEQA. Approval of the ordinance is exempt from further environmental review under the general rule in California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) that CEQA only applies to projects that have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. As a series of text amendments and additions, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that this ordinance will have a significant effect on the environment.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance, or its application to any other person or circumstance. The City Council of the City of San Leandro hereby declares that it would have adopted each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more other sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases hereof is declared invalid or unenforceable.

SECTION 5. **EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION.** This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after the certification of its approval by the voters at the Election pursuant to Elections Code section 9217. Upon approval by the voters, the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published according to law.
