I, the undersigned, HENRY ROOT, a single man, of the City and County of San Francisco, State of California, for and in consideration of the sum of THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR AND 18/100 DOLLARS (\$364.18), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

Do hereby grant unto the CITY OF SAN LEANDRO, a municipal corporation, for street purposes,

All that certain real property situate in the City of San Leandro, County of Alameda, State of California, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:-

(1) EEGINNING at the intersection of the Southwesterly line of "East Fourteenth Street" with the Eastern boundary line of "San Antonio Court", all as shown on a map thereof filed August 9th, 1913, in Book 28 of Maps at page 38, Alameda County Records, and running thence North 5° 13' West, along the Mortherly production of the said Eastern boundary line of "San Antonio Court" thirty-eight and twenty one-hundredths (38.20) feet to its intersection with the present Southwesterly line of "East Fourteenth Street" (formerly known as the "Oakland and San Leandro Road"); thence along the present Southwesterly line of "East Fourteenth Street" the following courses and distances, South 30° 55' 20" East, thirteen and twenty-four one-hundredths (13.24) feet; South 65° 12' 30" West, two and thirty-six one-hundredths (2.36) feet; South 25° 17' 20" East, ninety-six and sixty one-hundredths (96.60) feet and South 26° 26' 30" East, one hundred and eighty-one and forty one-hundredths (181.40) feet to a point in the bed of San Leandro Creek; thence down the bed of San Leandro Creek South 42° 01' West, ten and forty-five one-hundredths (10.45) feet; thence leaving said creek North 26° 38' West, parallel to and distant fourteen and twenty-seven one-hundredths (14.27) feet (measured at right angles) Southwesterly from the center line of the Southwesterly parapet wall of the bridge which spans the San Leandro Creek and said center line produced Morthwesterly two hundred and fifty-nine and thirty-two one-hundredths (259.32) feet to the place of beginning.

EMING Lot Numbered Forty-seven (47), as the same is delineated and so designated upon that certain map or plat entitled, "Plat. Showing lands to be taken for, and district to be assessed to pay the expenses of Opening and Widening East Fourteenth Street in the City of San Leandro, California, to a uniform width of 91 feet, from the Northerly line of Chumalia Street to the present Southeasterly line of Stanley Road produced Southwesterly; all as described in and in compliance with Resolution of Intention No. 606 N.S. of the Board of Trustees of said City of San Leandro adopted October 4th, 1915. San Leandro, Calif. March 30th, 1917." filed in the office of the County Recorder of said County of Alameda on the 5th day of September, 1917.

(2) BEGINNING at a point where the present South Westerly line of East 14th Street (formerly called Main County Poad from Oakland to San Leandro) intersects the Easterly line of that certain piece of land heretofore conveyed by Yanacio Peralta to María A. Toler, by deed dated December 29, 1854, and recorded in Liber "D" of Deeds, page 11, said point being seven (7) feet South Westerly from and parallel with the South Westerly line of said road, as the same existed in 1854, and being also South 5° 8' East fifteen and 99/100 (15.99) feet distant from the point of beginning of the description in said deed of said piece of land conveyed by Yanacio Peralta to Maria A. Toler; running thence South 5° 8' East along the line dividing the lands formerly of Wm. Moyes and A. H. Dear Sirs:

We have been giving further consideration to the San Leandro Public Park Case. The facts as we understand them are that prior to 1927 certain private owners conveyed land to the City of San Leandro with the provision in the deed that is was to be used for the purposes of a public park and that no building should ever be erected thereon save those incidental to park purposes and with further provision for a right of re-entry in the event of condition broken.

The question is whether by obtaining a release or quitclaim deed from the original owners, the City of San Leandro can now erect a City Hall and whether in such event, the title of the City to the land would be insurable.

We may start with the case of Spires vs. The City of Los Angeles (1906) 150 Cal. 64. There it was definitely held that where a parcel of land has been dedicated as a public park whether by set of the City or whether under the terms of a grant to the City, a purely municipal use may not be carried on on such land. The Court went on to say:

"Of course, if a municipality were undertaking to establish on this property a city hall, fire engine station, hospital or jail...... a different question would be presented and there would be little hesitancy in holding that it could not do so".

In the case of Slavich v. Hamilton (1927) 201 Cal. 299, the question was whether the City of Oakland and the County of Alameda were entitled to enter into a contract to erect a veterans memorial building on the park or plaza on Grand Avenue opposite the lake, known as Adams Park. The Supreme Court held that

In the case of Starich v. Hamilton (1987) gol Cal. 209, the quaston was whether the City of Ockland and the County of Alemeda ware entitled to enter into a contract to creek a wat- erans memorial building on the park or plane on Grand Avenue opposite the lake, known as Adams Fark. The Supreme Court held that

the particular purpose of a memorial building was consistent with park purposes. In the course of opinion, however, the Court referred to the fact that the original grantors or their successors had executed an instrument purporting to give, grant, etc. to the City the specific right to erect a veterans memorial building. The Court said about this release:

"But if the dedication of the property for park purposes was complete in the first instance, the property thereby became public property and the owners lost all control over it. If the dedication was complete by their acts, whether express or implied, it was thereafter irrevocable by them and the effect of such dedication cannot be qualified by any act or declaration thereafter made on their part. The property dedicated has become public property impressed with the use for which it was dedicated."

In the light of this language, it appears to be unquestionable that the rights of the public to enjoin the use of the public park property for any other purpose than that of a park would not be affected in any way by any release or quitclaim on the part of the original grantors or their successors.

You have called to our attention the provisions of Act No. 6375a, General Laws (Statutes, 1927, page 718, as amended by Statutes, 1929, page 753). This statute purports to give municipalities the rights to relinquish dedication of parks. We think that at least as to dedications occurring prior to the effective date of the statute it is unconstitutional. In the case of Hall vs. Fairchild-Gilmore-Wilton Company (1924) 66 Cal. App. 615, the Court stated that even the legislature has not the right to withdraw a dedication once made; and the Court refers to a case in Iowa which held a statute very similar to the California statute above mentioned to be unconstitutional.

The conclusion seems inevitable that any erection of a city hall on the San Leandro Public Park property would be subject to injunction on the part of any abutting property owner and probably on the part of any member of the general public.

We think that at least as to dedications occurring prior to the effective date of the statute it is ancenstitutional. In the case of Hall vs. Bairchild-Gilmore-Wilton Company (1924) as Oal. App. 615, the Court stated that even the legislature has not the right to withdraw a dedication once made; and the Court refers to a case in lowe which held a statute very similar to the California statute above mentioned to be unconsistationed.

In answer to your inquiry if this company would insure the title to the property conveyed to the City of San Leandro by Henry Root by the deeds referred to in our report No. 229396 in case the city erected thereon a city hall, you are advised that we would not deem such title insurable.

Reference to said deeds discloses the land was a gift upon condition that it be used only for a public purpose, to-wit: a park or public playground and that no buildings or other improvements be erected thereon except such as are used exclusively for such purposes.

The books abound with authorities to the effect that property dedicated to a particular public use cannot be put to other public use inconsistent with the use of the original dedication. An illustration of this rule is found in Spires vs City of Los Angeles, 150 Cal 64. In Mulvey vs. Wangenheim, 23 Cal. App. 268, the rule is carried further wherein it is determined that such a violation of the trusts upon which the land is held may be enjoined at the instance of an abutting owner whose property will thereby be damaged.

We are not unmindful of the rule that if the area of a park is used for buildings or activities of any character incidental to its use as a park, such use will be upheld by law, but in Slavich vs Hamilton, 201 Cal. 299, at page 306, it is said:- "A use for a public purpose may be utterly

inconsistent with a use for park purposes. Under the well-settled principle of law generally applicable, if the city were undertaking to establish in Adams Park a city hall, fire engine station, hospital, or jail, endeavoring to devote the property to the erection of municipal buildings or offices for use in the transaction of public business, we would have little hesitancy in saying that such purposes would be entirely inconsistent with the use of the property for park purposes."

This case also points out that the rule is more strict and the use more narrowly limited where the dedication is by private individuals than where the land is acquired by public purchase.

We now come to your question of the effect of a suit to quiet the title against the owner of the reversionary interest under said deeds. The most that could be accomplished thereby would be to remove the conditions subsequent and would leave unaffected the public trust under which the city holds title and which became fixed upon its acceptance of the deeds.

"The property dedicated has become public property, impressed with the use for which it is dedicated, and neither can the public divert it from that use, nor can it be lost by adverse possession. Nor is the effect of such dedication impaired by any delay in the use of the land for which it was set apart". Archer vs Salinas. 93 Cal. 43.
