

BEGINNING at the intersection of the Northerly line of Peralta Avenue, in said City of San Leandro, with the Northeasterly line of the right of way belonging to the Southern Pacific Railroad Company, and running thence along the Northeasterly line of said right of way, North 42° 43' West, 339.50 feet to its intersection with the Easterly boundary line of the land now or formerly owned by the Estate of Eleanor J. Haney, deceased; thence along said boundary line North 8° 55' East, 25.50 feet; thence South 42° 43' East 382.80 feet to the Northerly line of Peralta Avenue, and thence along the said line of Peralta Avenue North 78° 46' West 34 feet to the place of beginning.
