SUBJECT: State Realignments - Hartin at Freeway

On August 30, 1963 you forwarded to this office for review Realignment Nos. 31321 and 7860 of the State of California for portions of Hartin Blvd. at Hartin Freeway.

I have indicated on a sketch of the Hartin and Hartin Freeway intersection those areas which are involved in this realignment. Realignment No. 31321 was originally intended to go to Alameda County but due to pending annexation of the Adams and Henderson property the State was asked to grant annexation and then realign all of the parcels involved to the City of San Leandro. Realignment No. 7860 involves 2 parcels which were originally intended to be realigned to the City of San Leandro.

These realignments are the continuation of certain Freeway agreements in which the City, County and State agreed to have the State do certain work within the former City limits in connection with the construction of the Hartin Freeway and then upon completion of their work the City and County agreed to accept the return of the control of these streets into the City street system providing these streets were returned to the City in a satisfactory condition, namely equal to the condition they were upon acquisition by the State.

The conditions of the agreements regarding these realignments have been rendered by this office and the streets have been inspected and found to be in conformity with the Freeway agreements and therefore must be returned and accepted by the City. Note that there are two letters of transmittal and copies of each are to be acknowledged and returned to the State as specified. The balance of the documents attached should be filed in your office as a record of return of these properties to the City and evidence of transfer of title from the State of additional titles that were acquired by the State.
