WILLIAM T. PASCOE and WILLIAM H. CLARKE, hereby grant to the City of San Leandro, a municipal corporation, all that land situated in the City of San Leandro, County of Alameda, State of California, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the southeastern line of Williams Street with the northeastern line of Alvarado Street, as said streets are shown on the map of the Town of San Leandro, filed February 27, 1855, in Book 2 of Maps, page 43, Alameda County Records; thence southwesterly 30 feet along the last mentioned line to a point of cusp with a tangent curve concave to the southeast and having a radius of 30 feet; thence northwesterly, northerly, and northeasterly 47.12 feet along said curve to a point of cusp with a tangent line, being the said southeastern line of Williams Street; thence southwesterly 30 feet, more or less, along the last mentioned line to the point of beginning.

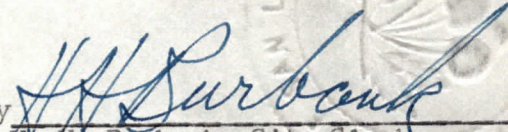
