AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made at San Leandro, California, as of February 7, 2023 | 7:01:50 AM PST between **Spencon Construction**, 3170 Crow Canyon pl. #250 San Ramon, CA 94583 Phone: (925) 984-2581, hereinafter called Contractor, and the CITY OF SAN LEANDRO, a municipal corporation, hereinafter called City, who agree as follows:

Recitals


The City has awarded a contract to the Contractor for performing the work hereinafter mentioned in accordance with the sealed proposal of said Contractor and of proceedings had and taken by the City Council of the City leading up thereto:

- 1. <u>WORK TO BE DONE</u>: The work to be done consists of **curb ramp upgrades**; and doing all appurtenant work in place and ready for use, all as shown in the plans and described in the specifications entitled "**Curb Ramp Upgrades for Paving 2021-23**" for the 'Base Bid Plus Additive Alternate A' option, now on file in the office of the **Engineer** of said City.
- 2. <u>TIME OF PERFORMANCE:</u> The work under this contract shall commence and be completed in accordance with the times therefore prescribed in the specifications for said work.
- 3. <u>PAYMENT</u>: The City will pay the Contractor for the performance of said work the prices as stated in the Contract Price Schedule for the 'Base Bid plus Additive Alternate A, and at the times and in the manner prescribed in the specifications.
- 4. <u>COMPONENT PARTS:</u> This Agreement shall consist of the following documents, each of which is on file in the office of the **Engineer** of said City, and all of which are incorporated herein and made a part hereof by reference thereto:

- 5. <u>WAGE SCALE</u>: Reference is hereby made to the General Wage Determination made by the Director of Industrial Relations and adopted by Resolution No. 77-236 of the City Council. Reference thereto is further made in the instructions and information to bidders. The provisions of the General Wage Determination made by the Director of Industrial Relations and Resolution No. 77-236 are hereby specified as the rate of prevailing wages to be paid workers on this project. For purposes of Labor Code section 1781, this project is a "public work" to which Labor Code section 1771 applies, and the Contractor and all listed or unlisted subcontractors must perform the work as a "public work." The Contractor has the responsibility for determining what is required to comply with its obligations under Labor Code section

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- 1771. Any decision by the Contractor or any listed or unlisted subcontractor not to comply with Labor Code section 1771 is at the Contractor's or subcontractor's sole risk.
- 6. <u>LABOR CODE COMPLIANCE</u>: Contractor indemnifies and holds harmless the City, its officers, officials, and employees, from and against claims, liability, and damages arising from any alleged violation of the California Labor Code asserted against the City due to the alleged acts or omissions of the Contractor or any listed or unlisted subcontractor used on the project.
- 7. <u>CLAIMS:</u> The City has the full authority to compromise or settle any claim relating to this project. The City will timely notify the Contractor if the City receives any third-party claim relating to this project.
